Kalyan Lantern interviewed renowned educator, MRS. SUNITA GEORGE, Principal, Bombay Scottish School, Mahim, Mumbai and herewith shares excerpts from the interview.

You have been associated with many prestigious schools. Could you share your experience with parents in terms of handling their expectations from the school and their children?

Handling parental expectations from school:

It is important that parents set realistic expectations from the school keeping in mind various factors like class sizes, school facilities and policies. In the best interest of the child, the parents and school should share a positive relationship based on mutual respect, trust and accountability. They should seek clarity on important queries and concerns related to the child's education from the school directly rather than depending on social media discussions. They should value the time of the school authorities and teachers, read all school circulars, attend meetings and other school events regularly, and also follow a constructive approach while receiving and sharing feedback.

> The partnership between the home and the school is significant for a child's success.

Handling parental expectations from children:

When it comes to the children, I think we sometimes try hard to make them what we want them to be rather let them be what they really are and want to become. While it is good to set higher benchmarks for the child, parents need to ensure that they do reality-checks from time to time. Unrealistic expectations suppress the child's individuality and create stress in the parent-child relationship. It is important that parents place themselves in their child's shoes while setting academic goals and behaviour expectations. Hence if we want our children to follow certain rules related to gadgets and screen-time or if we want them to develop positive reading habits, we need to walk the talk.

How can we work better at building 21st Century skills in our children?

(Question by Mrs. Gloria Frijo)

Some of these 21st century skills are collaboration, creative thinking, communication, technological skills and adaptability. Both parents and teachers can work together to develop these skills in children. Developing these skills is not a distraction but complementary to, and also enhances, core academic skills. At home, parents can encourage collaboration and conflict resolution by encouraging them to play team games and also by providing them unstructured play time so they can design their own games or devise new rules for some of the existing games. Children should be provided opportu-nities to identify, research, brain-storm and design creative solutions to some of the real world problems. What are the factors to be considered while finalizing a school for a child?

(Question by Mr. Jimmy George)

There are three aspects one needs to keep in mind while finalizing a school for your child.

A. Understand your child's interest, aptitude and attitude:

What kind of learning environment suits your child structured or less structured, challenging or friendly? How does your child learn best - in a group or enjoys working alone, learns by doing, is a visual learner or auditory learner, etc?

We do not agree on having a common syllabus for the country but believe in evaluating them on the basis of one entrance exam - Isn't that unfair to the student population at large?

(Question by Dr. Jasmin Johnson)

Educationists today are divided in their views on common syllabus or common board for the country. India is a diverse country in terms of language, lifestyle and culture. It is difficult to implement the one-nation, one-syllabus model. Different boards only provide more options to the students to choose the approach that best suits them. As far as evaluating them on the basis of one education system, it is the question of demand for quality and supply. The need today is more options for higher education programs in India. Students are also required to choose options based on their aptitude and interest rather than just following the herd mentality.

Do you think the unrealistic scores obtained in board exams these days will affect our students' morale when the system doesn't award them similarly going ahead?

(Question by Mrs. Linu Albert)

The students always assess themselves in comparison to the others who are pursuing the same programme. Hence, I do not feel it will dishearten them to see that they have scored less, because in comparison to the others pursuing the course they would still be at the same level.

Are CBSE and ICSE boards superior to the SSC board?

(Question by Mr. Jimmy George)

One cannot rate any board as superior or inferior. Each board has a different approach with respect to the layout of the curriculum, rigour and assessment patterns. The board does not matter today more than ever before. Unlike the Before-

B. Collect information about the shortlisted school:

This could include - class strength, facilities, discipline policies, expected academic rigour, expected parental time and effort, parent profile of the school, distance from residence, etc.

C. Parent expectations from the school:

List down your priority-wise expectations from the school. Based on the answer to the above questions try and choose the option that best meets your expectations, your child's personality, your family values and beliefs as opposed to the school's culture.

Google era, the focus of learning today is developing the ability to sift through information and use the relevant data effectively rather than remembering facts and reproducing them. The development of these skills is not dependent on the **'what'** of learning but on the **'how'** of learning. All the boards provide freedom to the school to adopt innovative classroom practices. The different national boards only outline the content; it is up to the school to design the delivery to meet requirements.

What would be your advice to today's parents and children?

The fifth generation technology is changing the labour landscape rapidly. We are moving into an era that belongs to the creative thinkers, problem solvers and entrepreneurs. We need to help our children to not only develop technical skills but also life-coping skills to deal with the challenges of the VUCA (volatility, uncertainty, complexity & ambiguity) world. As parents, we want to see our children thriving and may be driven by love, or paranoia and we try to micromanage our kids left, right and centre. We want to help our child at the first sign of them struggling. But may be that struggle is okay, and may be not every kid is going to be good at everything. Let them work hard and learn the art of working, strategizing and coping.

To the children, my message would be - 'Reflect within, understand yourself, take charge, set goals, allow yourself to experience different emotions and enrich yourself from different experiences. Be self-assured, authentic and free from judgement. Don't doubt your worth or the beauty of your truth. Bring out your unique colours and paint the world.

THE UNIQUE MISSION OF A TEACHER

It is said that the world of tomorrow is born from the schools of today. Teaching is a calling and it is not everyone who has the patience to mould the character of a student like a committed teacher. Bill Gates once said "If you want your child to get the best education possible it is more important to get him assigned to a great teacher than a great school". The role a teacher plays is multi-faceted one comprising many academic and social roles. In the academic role, she is a teacher, counselor, supervisor and a facilitator; a facilitator because she is involved in motivating pupils in

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knowledge acquisition and moral development. She is a counselor too and often assumes a parent surrogate, and most importantly, a confidante and a guiding light. A teacher prepares the students for their life outside the classroom. A teacher's job therefore cannot be equated with any other profession and is said to be a calling or mission and in Christian perspective, it amounts to evangelization.

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A. P. J. Abdul Kalam says "Teaching is a very noble profession that shapes the character, caliber and future of an individual. If people remember me as a good teacher that will be the

biggest honor for me". The mission of a teacher is to make a real and lasting impact in the hearts and lives of students in such a way that they are finally fit to lead a blissful life. "A good man out of the treasure of his heart brings forth good.... For out of abundance of the heart his mouth speaks." (Luke 6:45). Love is the most powerful force on earth. To be an effective and efficient teacher one needs to bear in mind the following aspects: The students respect and appreciate a teacher who has in-depth knowledge in his subject area. Good teachers need to be researchers who constantly update their knowledge and remain creative, innovative and effective in their teaching strategies. Technologies have developed to the extend where pupils have access to information on the internet and everything given to them can be cross-referred instantly. Today teaching is activity oriented and learner oriented. The traditional "chalk and talk" method of teaching that has persisted for hundreds of years is now acquiring inferior results when compared with the more modern and revolutionary teaching methods. Greater student interaction is encouraged, the boundaries of authority are being broken down, and a focus on enjoyment over grades is emphasized.

In spite of all these, teachers have to deal with various challenges which in turn can distract

and demotivate teachers. Some of the challenges include: the different styles of learning by different students, character development issues through the influence of media and misuse of technologies in the classrooms. In these situations, the teacher has to make active efforts to solve issues by correcting the individual privately without humiliating him publicly, closely monitoring them and identifying their interest and directing them to a passion in achieving that goal by the right judgment and encouragement. Such a teacher makes conscious decisions to inspire the next generation of leaders. Teachers therefore must exhibit energy, enthusiasm and cheerfulness, and never cease to learn.

Jesus: A Role Model for Teachers

Jesus was a teacher par excellence who exhibited a high rank of brilliance in explaining the most profound truths and complex issues in simple language to his listeners. He used story telling method with the help of parables. As an ideal teacher, He accepted the people as they are, loved them unconditionally, believed in their individuality and avoided difficult, philosophical terminologies while addressing the central issues that challenged His audience. It was not only the content of His teaching that attracted the crowd, but even more His personality. He had special concern, compassion and love for his listeners as that of an ideal teacher. His teachings shaped the core values of His audience. Regardless of our area of expertise, Jesus' example in teaching stands as an inspiring model in relating to students, as well as helping them grow and see the world in a different light! His aim was to transform behavior by transforming the inner man. That exactly is the ultimate mission of a teacher.

In Henry Adams words, "A teacher affects eternity, he can never tell where his influence stops".

It was always easier for a parent in the 80's and 90's to find a good school for their children. Now, with the progress of education, all schools are in the run for competing with one another with claims of offering 'high tech-facilities', 'better resources' and 'highly qualified teachers'. With such schools coming up, it gets difficult for parents to select the most appropriate school for their child; other than having to manage the aspect of high fees. But what might be more important to note is 'Are we raising our kids to be highly tech savvy and qualified, or courageous to face any difficulty that comes in their way?'

Being a young professor to degree college students since five years has enabled me to understand both sides of the story- the case of the teacher and the student. I have come across teachers who are highly qualified, well versed with the knowledge of their subject, but who fail to Deliver rightly. They would be flashing presentations one after the other, talking endlessly, giving enough notes and assigning various assignments. In response, the students strive endlessly to compete with fellow mates to achieve targets; the target being a "GOOD SCORE, CLASS AND RANK!". The end result of all this kind of imparting education would be producing 'tech savvy','information storing' robots.

Very rarely in the education process is there a stress on reviewing students as per the application of their lessons learnt. The entire education system is like an open stage- where students compete with each other for marks. Anything and everything they do is about the marks, including their attendance records. Everything seems to run smoothly until the day it is time to step into the field. The struggle begins right from the selection



process, the process might appear as a major blow to many as one is hardly asked about any subject content in interviews; it is always about the Application of the lessons learnt and the values one has

gained. One might even get lucky to get away with this struggle through institution driven placements; but are bound to be fired if they lack the necessary flexibility to deal with colleagues or multiple tasks that comes their way. I have heard about multiple cases of students who appeared to be bright in college with really good marks but are struggling hard to make a position for themselves at work. They are often heard complaining about 'the type of work allotted', majorly stressing on 'not able to produce in methods that they have been asked to'; whereas other cases where 'work life is hectic, but we are learning new things and managing tasks sensibly'. The difference is clear!

Reflecting on the past, being a ranker all throughout, not once in my working career have I had anyone asking me about my scores. All that we are judged on is our performance and deliverance. All that matters is to DELIVER smart, showcase your skills with the right attitude and a mind that strives to learn more every single day. Believe me, nothing more can be more satisfactory than being appreciated for your work than being appreciated for your results! Focus your best on learning, scoring will always pass by.

THE ONLY WAY AROUND A CHALLENGE Sometimes is through it

There is no doubt that the way we educate our children and the education system of our country is in dire need of reform. However, by the very nature of it, any reform that is sudden, is disruptive. Given that no one is sure of what method or system can replace the existing one, it is best to see reforms that are tested and then integrated into the existing system. However, we can foresee the process as lasting for a long time. What then of the students currently in school?

For anyone familiar with Darwin's theory of evolution, the idea of survival and environment being similar to that of a school is obvious. The environment, that is the school, rewards a certain type of temperament. Currently, students who are good at memorising thrive here. The ones that are creatively, athletically or intellectually inclined find it difficult to survive in schools.

As a teacher to my students and a student of the same flawed system, here is a little insight that I have from my personal experience. I have been an average student during my school days. I was fairly interested in art and terrible at Math. My grades were dire and I was least interested in my education. However, I was justified in my stance as it wasn't my fault that I was failing. It was the system that was faulty. It has always been inviting to the human mind to escape responsibility for one's own self or to shift the blame of misfortune to another. I see a lot of children today using the same excuse to justify their bad grades. And while it is true, it is important to realise that the justification is embraced not because it's true but because it is convenient. Well, what does that mean?

It means that if you blame the education system for your failure today and do nothing about it, you will become a complacent individual who will have the society, the government, their religion or God to blame for every failure you face in the future. It is difficult to take personal responsibility. Even more so today, where being a victim of something is considered a merit. If I fail, it is because I am a victim and if someone points out what I could have done instead, I can tell them they lack empathy and moral integrity. This attitude, if cultivated at school, transcends into life with disastrous effect.

Well, not everyone has the means to overcome and thrive. Not everyone can benefit from blaming themselves.



Absolutely. Life is unfair and we are forced to play the hand that we are dealt. Some people have it worse than others. And while they might be right, some force is trying to drag them to misery, the alternative to personal responsibility is complacency. In an environment like a school, we start with a single F in math. We do nothing about it because we think that is the fault of the system. The next time, we find multiple F grades in the report card and in no time we find ourselves out of school, on the couch while everyone else is in school. We fail to find any fulfillment in life and readily turn to drugs and end up in the fringes of society as an outcast. This is the story of many a people who have refused to accept responsibility for their own lives.

What do we do then?

We must understand that even though we might not be to blame for our failure, it is only appropriate that we work towards picking ourselves up where we find we are lagging. The idea is to cultivate a temperament where we take on the challenges that life throws at us and take responsibility for the situation at hand be it a financial crisis or a Math examination. While the system reforms itself to make subjects interesting the students will do well to use their talents and develop techniques to clear examinations, thus making them the very persons who survive the challenging environment and later work to change it.

WILL THE **DADS** STAND UP, PLEASE?

Anyone can father a child, but being a dad takes a lifetime. Dads play a role in every child's life that cannot be filled by others. This role can have a large impact on a child and help shape him or her into the person they become.

Dads and their daughters

Young girls depend on their fathers for security and emotional support. A father shows his daughter what a good relationship with a man is like. If a father is loving and gentle, his daughter will look for those qualities in men when she's of marriageable age. If a father is strong and valiant, she will relate closely to men of the same character.

Dads and their sons

Unlike girls, whose experience of their father's character shapes their expectations of men in general, boys model themselves after their father's character. For example, the young boy will develop attitudes towards women from the way his father interacts with the female members of the family and society. When a father is absent, young boys look to other male figures to set the "rules" for how to behave and survive in the world.

Dads and spiritual leadership

Many fathers unfortunately don't realize that God has ordained the father to be the spiritual leader of the family, while others simply don't understand how they should lead; still others simply refuse to lead. Actually this is an area in which they will be held accountable and here's the

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'bad news' for them: it simply can't be delegated. The leader-father gives the children their space and freedom, yet sets reasonable boundaries within which they operate. Fathers who give due importance to the children's catechism, church attendance, family prayers



and community involvement get rewarded by seeing the spiritual gifts sprout in their children, viz. charity, piety, obedience, fear of the Lord, wisdom, modesty, etc. The values of the father rub off onto the children and they learn to be honest, disciplined, respectful towards all and accountable for their actions.

Dads and Education

In traditional families, more so in our Malayalee culture, the husband tends to see the education of the children as the woman's job, no matter that she may be simultaneously holding down a full time job. In some cases he distances himself from the whole affair just so that he may not be blamed in case anything 'goes wrong' with the children's career. The worst case is where the father doesn't even know in which grade his child is studying! If the child requires extra tuitions, the man will fund it, but don't ask him to get involved in the choice of board or school or subjects or tuition teacher! As the child reaches the higher standards, a lot of decision making comes up, in terms of the stream to be opted for, the coaching class to be enrolled in and such like. These situations can become quite stressful for the mother if the father's involvement is not there.

Being an 'involved father' doesn't necessarily mean sitting down with the child's studies every evening like a subject tutor (though there are fathers who do that also). It simply means taking interest in their school work, guiding them with their homework, lending a helping hand with their projects, obtaining feedback from their teachers, attending the school open days, exhibitions, fun fairs, annual days and convocations. It also means just 'being there', by cutting down on meetings and parties outside office hours. It could also involve sacrifice in terms of giving up smoking or alcohol or sports shows in order to create a congenial study atmosphere at home. Social media addiction affects parents as much as kids and so the father should set a strong example in selfregulation. All of this means that in addition to all the hard work that the father has to put in the office, he also has to put a very different kind of hard work at home, for after all, parenting is not child's play!

Kahlil Gibran's advice on parenting is ever relevant: "For even as He (i.e. the archer/God) loves the arrow that flies, so He loves also the bow that is stable". The involved father is like the handle of this bow, providing the pull, while the mother is like the bow string, providing the push. When both are stretched, the arrow (i.e. the child) goes swift and far and hits its target!

"GAUDETE ET EXSULTATE" "REJOICE AND BE GLAD" CALL TO HOLINESS IN TODAY'S WORLD

- An Overview -

Pope Francis, in his Apostolic Exhortation, is trying to bring to the forefront a 'to-the-context' notion of sanctity and he exhorts all the faithful, to pursue the path of sanctity, notwithstanding all threats placed by the evil one on the way to holiness. He intends to evoke in every believer a new desire for holiness in a practical way.

MAIN THEMES AND THOUGHTS OF POPE FRANCIS ON HOLINESS

1. The Universal Call to Holiness

The saints who were never canonized as such are the ones who encourage us and accompany us in our weak moments. Our prayers must be raised to them as well. They are called the "saints next door". The canonized saints become for us, models of heroic virtues. It is the Lord who calls us to holiness. This call is for us too. Everyone who is called to holiness has a special mission to fulfil in life - a mission in Christ. The multifaceted activities within the Church and the Christian families taken up by the individuals can sanctify themselves and others. Sanctity demands that we be more alive in the Spirit and more human in character.

2. Two Subtle Enemies of Holiness

There are enemies who snatch holiness from those who are aspiring for it. The first enemy is the *'contemporary gnosticism'* which consists in an intellectual pursuit without God and without giving

importance to human sanctity. They exaggerate human perfection without grace. Gnostics fail to realize that our perfection is measured by the depth of our charity, not by information or knowledge alone. This is a doctrine without mystery. 'Gaudete et Exsultate' warns us that reason has its limits and that we should not totally depend on reason for answers to what pertains to God and humanity. The second enemy is 'contemporary pelagianism'. It emphasized the power of the human will. The same power that gnosticism attributed to the intellect, pelagianism attributed to the human will, to one's personal effort. Though modern pelagians speak of God's grace, they suggest that the human will is something pure, perfect, all-powerful, to which grace is then added. They fail to realize that 'Grace builds on nature'.

3. The Beatitudes as Signs of Holiness

The Beatitudes are Jesus' portrayal of what it means to be holy in our daily lives. Here "happy" and "blessed" become synonymous with "holy". According to the Beatitudes, holiness consists in going against the current. Instead of being rich, be poor so that you seek the fullness of the Spirit and you will attain the Kingdom. Instead of trying to be strong rulers who capture the earth by power, be meek, because by being meek you will inherit the Kingdom of God. Instead of being exuberant always, be mournful sometimes so that you will seek consolation in the Lord and you will attain the Kingdom of God. Instead of executing justice by violence, just hunger and thirst for justice and cry before the Lord and He will satisfy you fully. Enjoy the mercy of the Kingdom of God by being merciful and do away with all arrogance which destroys the Kingdom in oneself. Instead of fulfilling all the desires of the flesh, mortify every aspect of the body, mind and soul, so that you remain pure in heart and enjoy the Kingdom of God which is purity itself and you shall see God. Instead of being warmongers, be peacemakers, so that becoming children of God they shall enjoy the privileges of earthly life as well as those of the Kingdom of God. Instead of siding with an unjust system, be ready to be persecuted for righteousness' sake so that one can find a place at the right hand of the Father in His Kingdom.

The great criterion that is to be followed in attaining sanctity is total fidelity to the Master, developing ideologies striking at the heart of the Gospel and entering into a style of worship most acceptable to God.

4. Signs of Holiness in Today's World

There are five great signs of holiness to be lived in today's world. They are: (a) Perseverance, patience and meekness in facing difficulties and hostilities, (b) Joy and a sense of humour, which make us positive, hopeful and optimistic© Boldness and passion, in carrying out Christ's mission and to evangelize(d) Life in community, leading to communion of heart that "all may be one", and (e) A life supported by constant prayer, which raises us to the treasury of God's holiness.

5. Spiritual Combat, Vigilance and Discernment

Evil is present from the very first stage of creation. We should not dismiss the devil as a myth, lest we end up more vulnerable. Our path towards holiness is a constant battle for which the Lord equips us with prayer, the word of God, the celebration of Mass, Eucharistic adoration, sacramental Reconciliation, works of charity, etc. The path of holiness is a source of peace and joy, given to us by the Spirit.

The document speaks of discernment, which is all the more necessary today because contemporary life proclaims so many distractions as equally valid and good. Discernment is a grace. It requires listening to the Lord and to others, and to reality itself, which always challenge us in new ways. Discernment also entails listening to the Gospel and to the Magisterium that guards it. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to pour out upon us a fervent longing to be saints for God's greater glory and let us encourage one another in this effort. In this way, we will share a happiness that the world will not be able to take away from us.

Conclusion

Pope Francis concludes by placing before us Mother Mary as the perfect model of sainthood and exhorts us to whisper time and again the humble prayer, 'Hail Mary'.

Have come together in your Name

This prayer; 'have come together in your name' reminds us of the command of Christ Whenever you gather together in my name'. With reference to Eucharistic assembly St. Paul reminds; 'when you all gather together as a community' (1 Cor. 11:18). As we read in the acts of the apostles the early Christian community 'gathered together' on the first day of the week for the breaking of the bread' (20:7). Here 'have come together in your name' refers to the worshiping community. Jesus has promised His presence where two or three are 'gathered together' in His name (Mt. 18:20). The prayer 'in your name' also reminds us of the promise of Christ 'anything you ask for from the Father He will grant in my name' (Jn. 16:23-24). It also reminds us that Church is the community gathered together in the name of Christ to worship God.

Stand in your holy presence

This phrase 'stand in your holy presence' reminds us of the angels who 'stand in God's presence' (Lk. 1:19). As we see in the book of Revelation the heavenly group 'stand in front of the throne of the Lamb' while singing the praise of God (7:9-12; 8:23). Jesus says 'And when you stand in prayer' (Mk. 11:25). The oriental church has the tradition of the community standing while praying, praising and thanking God. Standing is the sign of joy and praise. So in our liturgy, the community stand in the presence of God together with the angels and praise God. In this prayer, 'stand in your holy presence' denotes that during this Gehanta prayer, the community is supposed to stand and pray.

Commemorate the Paschal Mystery

This prayer reminds us that in the Qurbana 'we commemorate ... the divine mystery of the passion, death, burial and resurrection of our Lord'. This means Qurbana is the commemoration of the Paschal Mystery. This mystery is given five qualifications they are great, awesome, holy, life giving and divine. Liturgy of the Church is centered on the paschal mystery of Christ (ccc 1337; 1409) and that is the foundation of all Christian faith. Our Qurbana is the commemoration of the paschal mystery, hence oriental fathers of the church explain the different parts of the celebration of Qurbana in relation to the Paschal Mystery of Christ. As the bread and wine prepared on the Beth Gaza are brought to the altar we remember Jesus being led to His passion and as they are offered in the form of the cross, we remember His death, and as they are placed on the altar and covered with the 'Sosappa' His burial and at the time of the words of institution again His death is remembered. At the time of Epiclesis, Prayer for the coming of the Holy Spirit, we remember Jesus' resurrection. At the time of the rite of fraction the Paschal mystery is again commemorated. So the death and resurrection of Christ is commemorated again and again. As Christians we are called to live the Paschal Mystery of Christ.

PROPHET ELIJAH

Israel was having a really bad time. King Ahab, not only hated God, he also forced the people in his kingdom to worship false Gods. One day, a prophet, named Elijah walked into the king's palace. Elijah warned the king that if he did not stop his idolatry, there would be famine all over the kingdom. The king did not pay heed to this warning.

After this warning. God sent Elijah to a guiet place in the country. God sent ravens to get food for the prophet. They brought him bread and meat, and Elijah drank water from the brook. Meanwhile, the entire country dried up as there was no rain at all. Elijah's words were coming true. The whole country was thirsty. The crops didnot grow as there was no water. The widow trusted Elijah and did as he said. For several days, neither did the flour diminish nor did the jar of oil run dry. One day, something unpleasant happened. The widow's son died. Elijah carried the boy to the upper room and cried out, "O Lord, please bring this child back to life." Sounds impossible? But, for the good Lord, nothing is impossible. Burkina Faso church attack: Priest among six killed

Gunmen have killed six people including a priest as Mass was being celebrated in a church in Dablo in northern Burkina Faso. It began on May 12, 2019 at about 09:00 (GMT and local time), during Mass. The attackers, said to number between 20 and 30, then burned down the church.The town's mayor, OusmaneZongo, said that there was panic as other buildings were burned down and a health centre looted.Jihadist violence has flared in Burkina Faso since 2016, and this is the third attack on a church in five weeks.

The landlocked country in northwest Africa has been beset by extremist violence in recent months as Islamist terror groups expand their reach. The number of violent incidents in the country linked to the local affiliates of al Qaeda and ISIS rose from 24 in 2017 to 136 in 2018, according to a report by the Africa Center for Strategic Studies.



Pope condemns Sri Lanka attacks as acts of 'cruel violence'

Pope Francis condemned the attacks in Sri Lanka that killed hundreds of people as acts "of cruel violence" as he celebrated Easter mass at St Peter's Square at the Vatican.

"I learned with sadness and pain of the news of the grave attacks, that precisely today, Easter, brought mourning and pain to churches and other places where people were gathered in Sri Lanka," the pontiff said.

"I wish to express my heartfelt closeness to the Christian community [of Sri Lanka], wounded as it was gathered in prayer, and to all the victims of such cruel violence."

"I entrust to the Lord all those who have tragically perished," he said. "And I pray for the injured and all those who suffer as a result of this tragic event."



Update: Pro-life leaders applaud passage of abortion bill in Alabama

MONTGOMERY, Ala. (CNS) -- By passing a bill to ban abortion in nearly all circumstances, the Alabama Legislature has recognized that abortion is "the extinguishing of a unique human life," said the president and CEO of Americans United



for Life. "From conception to natural death, every single human life deserves to be protected by law. The violence of abortion is never the answer to the violence of rape," said Catherine Glenn Foster in a May 15 statement. "Like other states that have passed laws concerning when life begins, Alabama has relied upon scientific and medical facts."

The state Senate passed the measure late May 14 in a 25-6 vote. The state House of Representatives overwhelmingly approved it in early May. It includes exceptions for when the life or health of the mother is seriously threatened and when the child has a fatal disease. It bans abortion in all other circumstances, including rape and incest, and makes performing an abortion at any stage of pregnancy a felony punishable by up to 99 years in prison.

Question: IF GOD HAS MADE US TO BECOME SAINTS, HOW CAN WE DO SO?

KNOW FAITH

Answer:

Be 'canonisable':

God undoubtedly wants us to spend eternity with him, but it's not a free pass. A good test is that other people should be able to look at my life and exclaim "that is how I should live my life!" So if I am a spouse or a student or a priest or a clerk, people should be able to look at my life as a great witness to how a married life should be, how a student life should be, how a priestly life should be, how a working life should be, according to holiness. Even Pope Francis, in general audience on June 21, 2017, said that saintliness does not consist in praying all day, but rather in doing your ordinary duties, whether it be going to work or taking care of the home, with a heart always open to God.

Practical tips for getting in:

A church document called Lumen Gentium (LG50) says that the (canonized) saints are the sure and safe guides to get us to heaven. All of them teach us at least two things:

(a) Be Eucharistic centric, i.e. believe that Jesus is really, truly and substantially present in the Holy Eucharist. This could be demonstrated by Eucharistic adoration, participating in Holy Qurbana, receiving Holy Communion reverently and worthily and making spiritual communion at other times. (b) Be Marian, i.e. rely very especially on Mary's intercession. Develop a filial bond with her by bringing her flowers and joyfully celebrating all her feasts, and above all by praying the full rosary every day, and encouraging others to do so.

Obstacles:

- A culture of instant gratification: We don't want to follow the process laid out above. We want everything to happen NOW. That won't do. We must come to love the process, with all its dryness, distractions and difficulties.
- b) An unwillingness to commit: We always want to keep our options open. We hesitate to say a total YES to God, because that means closing all our other options, but God wants our total commitment.

Lack of fighting spirit: We don't want to discipline ourselves. We are unable to say NO to ourselves. We want to believe that Satan has made a truce with us, when in reality the spiritual battle is fiercely raging!
